TRADE WASTE AT TIVERTON MARKET



WHAT CAN GO IN THE RECYCLING BIN	
CARDBOARD Includes all cardboard, card, flat-packed boxes, tetra packs and cartons	
PAPER Includes white and coloured paper, shredded paper, envelopes, magazines, newspaper, telephone directories, catalogues, paper towels and books	
PLASTIC Includes milk bottles, plastic packaging/lids, bubble wrap, cellophane, plastic bottles and tubs, carrier bags, cling film, plant pots and seed trays	
TINS & CANS Includes all food tins and drink cans plus large tins, empty aerosol cans, tin foil and foil-lined crisp packets	
WHAT SHOULD GO IN THE GENERAL WASTE BIN	
FABRICS Includes mixed textiles and clothes, wool, shoes	(P)
NB: We ask that quality textiles are donated to a local charity instead of being disposed of with general waste	A -
FOOD WASTE Including cooking oil	
GARDEN WASTE Waste from plant stalls at the Market – not household garden waste	D
GENERAL WASTE Includes CD/DVD/Games discs and scrap metal	
GLASS Any types of mixed or clear glass, bottles or jars	
WHAT CAN'T BE DISPOSED OF AT TIVERTON MARKET	
BULKY WASTE Tyres, carpet, furniture, wood and timber, appliances with CFCs, plaster board, hard-core and rubble or building materials	
ELECTRICAL ITEMS Including any electrical appliances, light bulbs, florescent tubes or batteries	9
HAZARDOUS WASTE Including bio-hazardous waste, gas bottles, paint, engine oil, asbestos
